Tournament Rules

1. Competitors may enter only one singles and one Doubles event.
2. Entries must be made on the prescribed entry form. Entry fees is \$50.00 per event.
3. TennisTT registration fees of \$40.00 per player. Payment must accompany completed registration forms.
4. Entry forms are available on the tournament website or at the following venues: TennisTT Office and Harry's Sports World, St James Street San Fernando and Cite Up Limited, Princess Margaret Street San Fernando and Rhonda Mohammed, Shaw Park Tobago, or committee members.
5. Completed entry forms are to be submitted to any of the locations listed above.
6. Entries close on Friday 16th January 2015, and the draw will be made at 5:00pm on Wednesday 21st January 2015 at Cite Up Limited on 11 to 15 Princess Margaret Street San Fernando.
7. Matches will commence at 9:00am Saturday and Sunday.
8. Players must report to the officials' desk immediately upon arrival for their match on each day of the tournament.
9. See Match formats above.
10. Competitors are expected to note the dates of fixed for their matches, posted at the notice board at the venue. While every effort will be made to ensure that the fixtures are published in the print and or tournament website, this cannot be guaranteed.
11. Players are required to play in acceptable tennis attire. Where the tournament is being funded by a corporate sponsor, no locally branded attire will be allowed on the court.

12. Doubles teams are encouraged to wear similar clothing during their matches.
13. All complaints should be lodged in writing to the referee within one hour of the conclusion of the match.
14. The referee may exercise discretion in postponing a match on account of weather or condition of the court. In any such case of postponement, the previous score shall hold unless the referee and the players agree unanimously otherwise. Players may be required to finish matches under lights or on a different surface.
15. The TennisTT South Zone committee reserves full power, subject to the rule of TennisTT, to alter the conditions and programme in any way they think proper and in the interest of the tournament.
16. The decision of the Committee in all matters pertaining to the tournament shall be final.
17. A player whose conduct violates accepted standards will be reported to the council of TennisTT and disciplinary action may be taken against him or her by TennisTT. In addition, a play may be penalised under the following system:
 - a. Point Penalty System, for:
 - i. Unreasonable delay after warm up period, between points, when changing ends, and otherwise unreasonably delaying a match.
 - ii. Audible obscenity
 - iii. Visible obscenity
 - iv. Violence or with anger, hitting, kicking or throwing the tennis ball, racquet or other equipment.
 - v. Verbal or physical abuse of any official, opponent or other person.
 - vi. However, after the third code violation, the referee shall determine whether each subsequent offence shall consider default. The chair umpire, the referee or his / her assistant will levy these penalty points.
18. Any player not ready to play within 15 minutes after the match is called shall be defaulted. However, the referee in his/ her discretion of all relevant circumstances may elect not to declare a default.
